SCABIES UPDATE:

Key points about scabies

- Scabies is a contagious skin condition that causes a very itchy rash.
- The rash is caused by an allergic reaction to a tiny mite that burrows under your skin.
- It's easily spread between people through close skin-to-skin contact or shared bedding or clothing, and won't go away without treatment.
- Everyone in your household should be treated at the same time, even if they don't have symptoms.
- You'll also need to clean bedding and clothing that was used in the last 4 days at the same time.

Remember you can also give Nicki (our Public Health Nurse) a call on 021 195 7308 for some free advice, or pop in to see her on a Tuesday at school between 2-3pm.
