COOLER DAYS – Please ensure children are dressed for the colder conditions. School is still open on rainy days.

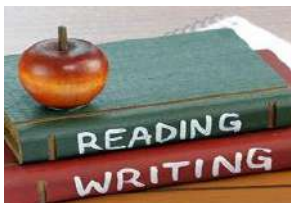
