- **LATENESS**: School starts at 8:45am! Lateness counts towards absence. For students with ongoing patterns of lateness I am happy to meet with whanau to look at a support plan, together.
- <u>SWEET TREATS</u>: Keep chocolate, lollies, chewing gum, big bags of chips and big packets of biscuits at home. These are treat foods that can be enjoyed at home. If students bring these to school, these will be held by teachers for the day and returned to your child at the end of the day. We have free fruit and lunches in schools.
- WATER ONLY SCHOOL: We are a Water Only School.
- FINGERNAIL CARE: We don't mind students wearing nail polish, but they **must not wear** FAKE LONG/SHORT NAILS. Students will be asked to remove them. This is for Health and Safety reasons to avoid injury to themselves and others. We have seen severe injuries in the past and do not want a repeat of this.
